

Tasting notes

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2021

Matured in French oak this smooth full-bodied 100% Cabernet Sauvignon exudes dark chocolate and coffee on the nose, and is smooth on the palate with a burst of berry tones. A natural accompaniment to hearty red meats, or mature cheddar.

Soils: Franschhoek Valley alluvial sandstone

Alc 14.29%

Residual sugar 1.6 g/lw

Total acidity 5.0 g/l pH 3.61

MERLOT 2020

Koffie Klip shale vineyards are the secret to the delicate balance and freshness of this lighter Merlot with a touch of Cabernet Sauvignon. Bright, spicy, cherry and raspberry fruit make it an ideal wine for easy drinking. Maturation in French oak contributes refined, smooth tannins.

Soils: Vines planted in a combination of well-weathered granite soils and beautiful “Koffie Klip” shale slopes.

Residual sugar 2.9 g/l

Total acidity 5.1 g/l pH 3.61

ROSÉ 2021

Dry, crisp, salmon-pink wine offering fresh strawberry and raspberry flavours. Sufficiently light and fresh for lunchtime enjoyment. Merlot grapes from the Voore-Paardeberg were bled during the wine-making process to create a zippy, breezy rosé.

Soils: 20-year-old vines grown on granitic soils of the Paardeberg Mountain. Clay blends softness, green cropping and micro irrigation preserve the natural acidity and freshness.

CHENIN BLANC 2022

Older low-yielding Chenin vines produce concentrated white peach and tropical fruit flavours, while extended lees maturation offers a creamy mouthfeel in this delicious dry white wine with a delightful fruity, flinty finish.

Soils: Weathered granitic soils, low yield, ensures concentration of fruit flavours.

Alc 12.5%

Residual sugar 6.6 g/l

Total acidity 5.7 g/l pH 3.361

ELGIN SAUVIGNON BLANC 2021

High altitude Elgin provides the ideal cool climate for dry, racy and vibrant Sauvignon Blanc. Extended lees contact in stainless steel tanks provides intense gooseberry, granadilla and citrus flavours.

Soils: Grown high in the foothills of Elgin's Groen Landberg (green land mountains) on medium-textured gravel and clay soils.
